Responses from 36 alumni (n=36) were collected on Curriculum, Course,

Teaching-Learning and Evaluation that show that out of 100% 72.2% alumni were agreed on the fact that the curriculum and syllabus content were appropriate for their higher education. 61.1% alumni agreed that during their study period sufficient number of co-curricular activities were arranged by the college. 63.9% alumni said that office of the college always provided them college-university-government information for students benefit. 33.3% alumni agreed that the institute / faculty helped them in placement /higher education. 61.1% alumni agreed that the institute gave them information about government scholarships for students. 63.9% students agreed that the learning environment in the college was good.
