Responses from 36 alumni (n=36) were collected on Curriculum, Course, Teaching-Learning and Evaluation that show that out of 100% 72.2% alumni were agreed on the fact that the curriculum and syllabus content were appropriate for their higher education. 61.1% alumni agreed that during their study period sufficient number of co-curricular activities were arranged by the college. 63.9% alumni said that office of the college always provided them college-university-government information for students benefit. 33.3% alumni agreed that the institute / faculty helped them in placement /higher education. 61.1% alumni agreed that the institute gave them information about government scholarships for students. 63.9% students agreed that the learning environment in the college was good. Similar number of the alumni (63.9%) agreed with the fact that the college environment was very secured and they experienced no menace from outside elements during their study period. 52.8% alumni agreed that the curriculum accommodates courses with experiential learning(hands-on). 63.9% alumni agreed that all the academic processes of the college are transparent. 66.7% alumni agreed that the college creates a balance between student-centric and teacher –centric in all its academic activities.
