

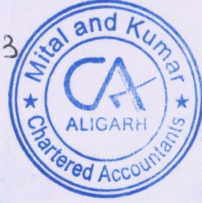

Introduction



Significance of the Seminar
