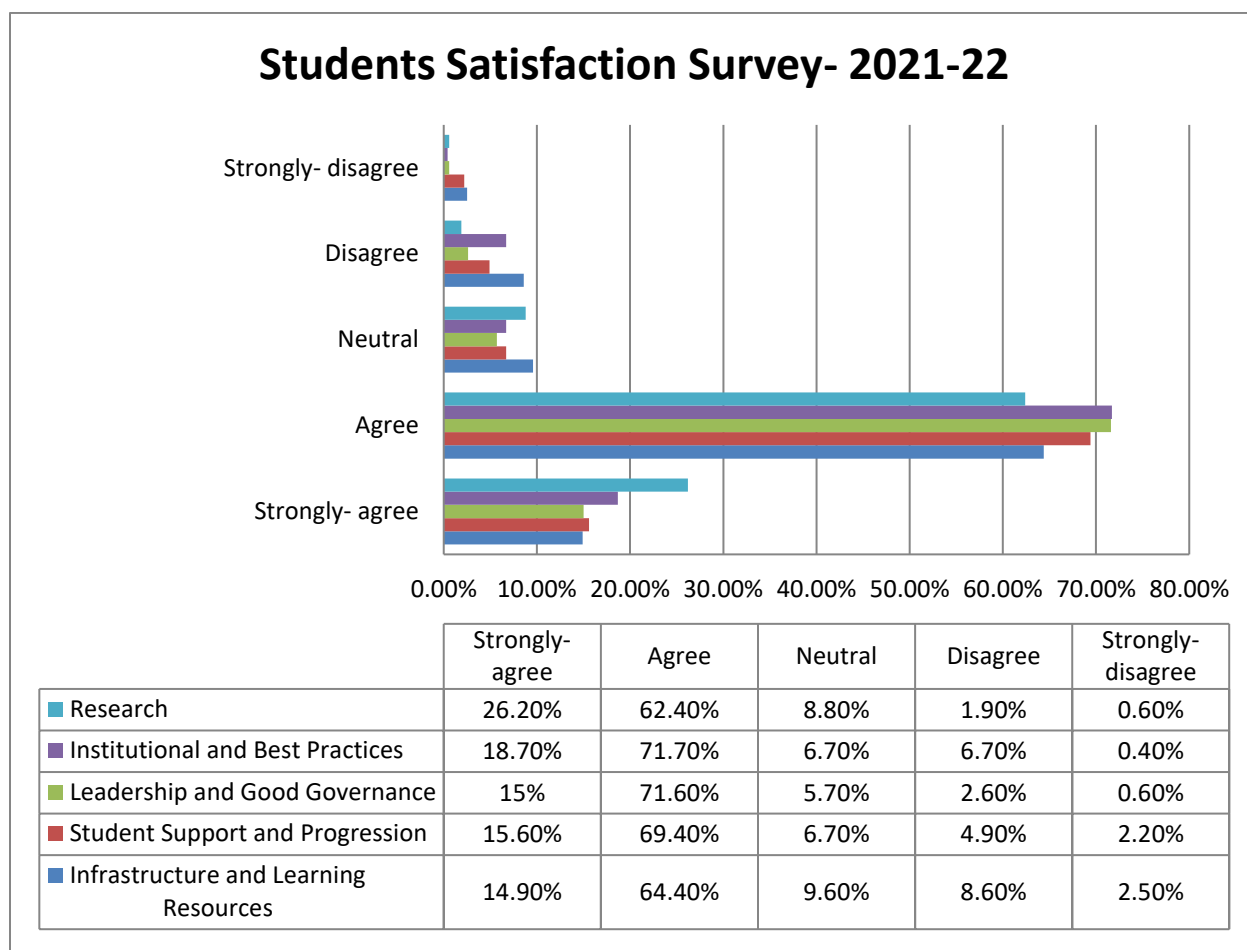


Students Satisfaction Survey 2021-22

This study investigated the student's perception towards infrastructure and learning, students support and progression, leadership and good governance, institutional and best practices and research in educational institute Sri Tikaram Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Aligarh. This study utilized a descriptive quantitative design to obtain the opinion of the respondents. Students were selected for this study on the basis of stratified random sampling. The sample size consists of 475 students are from under-graduation courses and 70 students from post-graduation courses.

Five- point Likert scale was used to collect the opinion of student perception of educational institute Sri Tikaram Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Aligarh. Five- Likert scale indicates with one being strongly-agreed, second is agreed, third is neutral, forth is disagreed and fifth is strongly-disagreed. After constructing a questionnaire, a pilot study conducted and reviewed the questionnaire, to know the feasibility of questionnaire. Questionnaires were distributed to participants by using Google form.



Findings

This study concludes that in infrastructure and learning resources of college 14.9% of students are strong- agreed, 64.4% are agreed, 9.6% of students give their neutral response, 8.6% have disagreed and 2.5% of students are strong- disagreed. This parameter was checked by statement 1. The laboratory has ample equipment and resources. 2. Study material related to the course is available in the library 3. The facilities of the reading room are excellent. 4. Computer training is provided. 5. First-aid facility is available in the college 6. Students are satisfied with the internet access in the college. 7. Students are satisfied with the quality of food, cost, cleanness and services available in the college canteen. 8. The college incorporates value-added, Vocational and Technical courses in its curriculum. 9. The sanitation facilities in the college are clean and hygienic. 10. The teachers use ICT and teaching aids in the class to facilitate students.

Our study found that 15.6% of the students are strong- agreed, 69.4% are agreed, 6.7% give their neutral response, 4.9% are disagreed and 2.2% are strongly disagreed with students' support and progression of college. Their satisfaction level has been checked by statement 1. The college has adequate sports facilities. 2. Opportunities are available to participate in sports competitions at all levels. 3. The National Service Scheme (NSS) through various camps helps uncover the versatility of the students. 4. Rovers and Rangers Activities Provide Opportunities for Community Development and Recreation. 5. Along with training, various levels of examinations are also organized under NCC (National Cadet Corps). 6. Students get opportunities to enhance their talent through cultural programs. 7. Song, poetry, essay and debate competitions are organized from time to time to nurture literary talents. 8. Student union activity in college is efficient. 9. Student Welfare Board helps resolve the problems of the students. 10. The Proctorial board can maintain discipline in the college.

For leadership and good governance of the college, this study concludes that 15.0% of respondents are strong- agreed, 71.6% are agreed, 5.7% of them gave their neutral response, 2.6% are disagreed and 0.6% are strongly disagreed. The satisfaction level of respondents is checked by statement 1. In college, leadership attitude is developed by the students through teaching and other activities. 2. There is full participation of the student union in the college. 3. The work culture of college is capable of making you a good citizen. 4. The celebration of Women's Day, Gandhi Jayanti, Independence Day and Republic Day helps to infuse value education. 5. The Principal responds to student grievances.

This study also concludes that in institutional and best practices of college 18.7% of students are strong- agreed, 71.7% are agreed, 6.7% give their neutral response, 6.7% have disagreed and 0.4% are strong- disagreed. The criteria are checked by statement 1. The workshop and seminar about educational and social policy enhance awareness among the students. 2. The premises of the college is clean and environment friendly. 3. The college administration is very cordial and cooperative. 4. The college activities provide all-around development for the students. 5. Teachers are concerned and helpful regarding the progress of the students. 6. The students are

enriched with the constitution values.7. Awareness programmes about the Indian constitution are held in the college.

The study also conclude that 26.2% of students are strongly agreed, 62.4% are agreed, 8.8% give their neutral response, 1.9% disagreed and 0.6% are strongly disagreed with research perception. For analyzing research perception of college the study checked by the statement1. My teachers encourage personal interest and enthusiasm for the research field. 2. My teachers can explain the subject matter effectively. 3. My learning is stimulated when education is grounded in research. 4. It is important to me that my teacher inculcates research abilities.5. The research culture at the institute stimulates my learning process6. The teacher is well aware of the recent trends and identifies future research.
